Women's Forest Congress Glossary of Terms

- CONGRESS** A formal meeting or series of meetings for discussion between delegates, especially those from within a particular discipline.
- FOREST COMMUNITY** All who live in, manage, steward, work in, work for, care for, play in, and love all types of forests.
- FOREST SPACE** The freedom and scope to live, think, and develop in a way that suits one, some, or many.
- FOREST** Our use of forest – areas consisting of trees and undergrowth – includes the vast contiguous forests of rural areas, large and small patches of forests in suburbs, and the clusters of trees that are found in urban parks and communities.
- FORUM** A physical or virtual place, meeting, or medium where ideas and views on a particular issue or issues can be exchanged. WFC's forum has taken the form of a movement that resonates with many, as well as virtual gatherings. In 2022, our forum will include the movement, virtual events, and an in-person gathering.
- MISSION** What WFC is doing to help reach its Vision: how we do our work together and what we are doing. WFC's mission will inevitably evolve over time; for now, it is focused on what we are doing leading up to and at an in-person Congress in 2022.
- VISION** Vision is the world we want to see. It's the broader need that we believe the WFC is working toward. It is the future state.
- WE** Our use of "we" includes the Steering Committee, Advisory Council, Working Group Members, and all who have attended or participated in past events.
- WOMEN** Our use of "women" is meant to include trans, non-binary, and gender non-conforming participants, as well as women of all ages, perspectives, cultural backgrounds, professional levels, and education.
