Women's Forest Congress: Our Use of Terms

CONGRESS

A formal meeting or series of meetings for discussion between delegates, especially those from within a particular discipline, who are working toward a shared vision

FOREST COMMUNITY

All who live in, manage, steward, work in, work for, care for, play in, and love all types of forests.

FORESTS

Areas consisting of trees and undergrowth – includes the vast contiguous forests of rural areas, large and small patches of forests in suburbs, and the isolated and clustered trees that are found in urban parks and communities.

FORUM

A physical or virtual place, meeting, or medium where ideas and views on a particular issue or issues can be exchanged. WFC's forum has taken the form of a movement that resonates with many, as well as virtual gatherings. In 2022, our forum will include the movement, virtual events, and an in-person gathering.

WE

"We" includes the Steering Committee, Advisory Council, Working Group Members, and all who champion our mission and events.

WOMEN

"Women" is meant to include trans, non-binary, and gender non-conforming participants, as well as women of all ages, perspectives, cultural backgrounds, professional levels, and education.
